Louise J. Willis, age 85, of Jonesville, VA passed away peacefully on September 25, 2014 following a brief illness.

She was born June 1, 1929 in Cumberland, KY to the late Arthur and Lillie Cole Jones. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Earl Willis; two brothers, Harold Jones and Rob Jones; and one sister, Pauline Green.
