



## Ann Cawood

July 15, 1934 - April 17, 2014

Elizabeth Ann Cawood, 79, of Jonesville, Virginia, passed away on Thursday, April 17, 2014 at Wellmont Holston Valley Medical Center after a brief illness.

She was a resident of Lee County, Virginia, a member of Flatwoods United Methodist Church at which she taught Sunday school and sang in the choir. A retired professor of 25 years at Pensacola Junior College, now Pensacola State College, Ms. Cawood served the college in several roles. She was an alumnus of Union College in Barbourville, Kentucky and the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, Tennessee. Ms. Cawood was an active member of the Cedar Hill Ladies Golf Association, was one of the first women to serve on the board for that organization, as well as donating funds for golf course improvement. She won several of the Ladies Invitational Women's Club Championships from the 1970's through the 1990's. She also served on boards and committees for local business, government, and community service associations. Always an inspiration for children, she donated time and money to support local children's programs.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Carter Champ Cawood, and Ruby Nell Smith Cawood.
