Bainard Collins, 90, of Jonesville, VA, passed away on Thursday, May 22, 2014 at Indian Path Medical Center.

A native of Blackwater, VA, he was born January 13, 1924 to the late Alec and Rosie Gibson Collins. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Isaac and Martin and by three sisters, Etta, Euna Mae and Pauline.
