January 4, 1938 - December 15, 2024

Betty Jean Horner Hines, 86, of Jonesville, VA, passed from this world to her Heavenly Home on Sunday, December 15, 2024, at Lee County Community Hospital, surrounded by family.

She was born on January 4, 1938 in Dorchester, VA to the late Eugene and Minnie Horner. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Dr. Benjamin Harrison Hines, sisters, Charlotte Brooks, Lois Gibson, Sarah Brooks and Cybil Horner, her step-son, Benjamin Hines, and by her son-in-law, Jerry Crusenberry.

Betty attended Williamson School of Nursing in West Virginia. She began her nursing career at St. Mary's Hospital in Norton, VA where she touched many lives. While there, she met the love of her life, Dr. Benjamin Hines, whom she married in 1960. She worked as his nurse until his death in 1972. She then began working at Heritage Hall Nursing Home in Big Stone Gap, VA, where she loved and nurtured countless patients and their families for 31 years until her retirement.

Betty loved all people and had a way of making each person feel special. Her whole life was a testimony of her faith and no matter the earthly circumstances, she always found so much to be grateful for and considered herself very blessed. She never failed to tell everyone how good that the Lord

had been to her. She was a lifelong member of the Baptist Church of Norton, but attended Bowling Chapel Methodist Church in Jonesville for over 60 years. She was also a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and of the Red Hat Society.

Betty was an incredibly gifted musician who loved to play piano. She will be remembered as the "Life of the Party" for her talents and her ability to bring smiles and laughter to everyone.

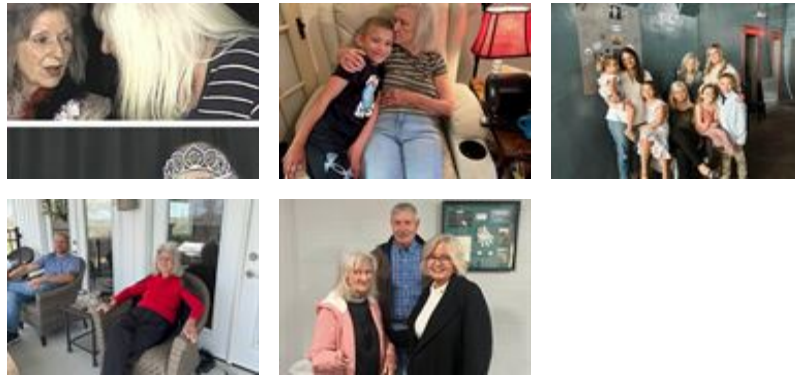
