Betty Rosenbaum Laningham, 97, passed away on Sunday, April 29, 2018 at Oakmont at Gordon Park, Bristol, VA.

She was born on December 11, 1920 in Jonesville, Virginia and was a lifelong resident of Lee County. A graduate of Radford University, she taught for many years at Flatwoods High School. She was a member of the Pennington Gap First United Methodist Church and the Rebecca Circle.
