Claude Pennington, 82, of Jonesville, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, February 17, 2026, at Holston Valley Hospital, surrounded by his beloved family.

He was born in Lee County to the late Claude A. Pennington II and Eula Ellen (Jones) Kirk. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his step-father, Ed Kirk and by his step-mother, Jo Pennington.

Claude was a Vietnam Era U.S. Army Veteran who was deployed in Italy. The majority of his career was spent in electronics. He owned and operated CC&S and later retired from the Lee County School System, where he had taught electronics and worked in their networking systems.

Claude was a long time member of Jonesville First United Methodist Church. He was a very talented man of many talents that included things such as machinist, gunsmithing, building late model race car engines, among many other things. He also loved spending time shooting with his friends and family at Kettlefoot and Cherokee Gun Clubs. Above all, he cherished time with his family.

Claude is survived by his wife of 61 years, Christine Pennington; one son, Stephen Pennington and wife, Jennifer, of Nickelsville, VA; two grandchildren,

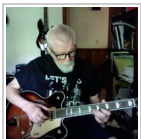
