



Daniel "Dan" Jack Scott

November 3, 1925 - March 15, 2018

Daniel (Dan) Jack Scott, 92, was greeted at Heaven's Gate in the arms of his Lord and Savior on March 15, 2018.

Dan was born on November 3, 1925 to Ethel and Ezra Scott and lived the majority of his life in the Flatwoods community of Jonesville, VA. He was proud of many accomplishments in life, but the two he spoke of more often than others were the fact that he had been married to his wife, June Estep Scott, for 69 years, and that he was the oldest member of his church (Thompson Settlement Baptist Church) where he attended since he was a child.

He was blessed with four children Angela Turley (Bill), Jan Long (Chris), Danny (Alice) and Rick; four grandchildren, Bart (Heather) Long, Alison Turley (Danny) Jessee, Emily Scott (Will) Crabtree and Kendrea Scott (fiancé Andrew Hensley) and four great-grandchildren that were the light of his life, Rylan Jessee, Will Jessee, Gant Long and Gatlin Long. He is survived by one brother, Herbert (Margaret) Scott along with special nieces and nephews, and a host of friends.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason and attended Wynn Masonic Lodge, a member of the Scottish Rites, a WW II Army Veteran (serving in the Pacific Theater) and an honorary member of the Lee County Garden Club.

He retired from the United States Department of Agricultural, had worked for the U. S. Postal Service, and owned and operated Dan Scott's Grocery. Since his retirement he spent time on the farm where he enjoyed tending his cattle. He was an avid sports fan who enjoyed watching basketball and baseball and was known for giving some advice to his children and grandsons on how to play the game.

He will be remembered for his contagious smile and a witty personality. His kindness and generosity were a silent witness as he gave many a hand up when they were in need.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his siblings Ezra, Jr., Ronald, Bernard, John, Ruth, and Ercelle.

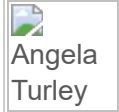
