Dennis Cale Hines, 78, of Jonesville, VA, passed away on Friday, March 13, 2020, at Bristol Regional Medical Center.

Dennis was born on August 21, 1941 in Lee County to the late Edgar Lee Hines and Virginia Pendleton Hines. He served in the U.S. Navy on the USS Hornet from 1960-1964. He started working for the phone company in 1965 and spent the next 35 years working in telephone communications. He was a member and former deacon at Friendship Baptist Church, who was a dedicated bible reader.
