Edith Chadwell Wolfenbarger, 105, of the Caylor community of Ewing, VA, passed away peacefully on November 26, 2018 at Lee Health and Rehabilitation Center in Pennington Gap, VA.

She was born on July 25, 1913 in the Dry Branch area of Ewing to the late Harvey and Martha Frances “Fannie” Ayers Chadwell.

Affectionately known as “Cook”, she took over the cooking and household responsibilities upon her mother’s death. Having accepted Christ on July 25, 1931, she was a lifelong member of Mountain View Baptist Church in Ewing.
