Elmer Ewell Bledsoe, 92, of Jonesville, VA passed away on Tuesday, December 13, 2022 at the James H. Quillen VA Medical Center.

He was born in Lee County, VA on May 29, 1930 to the late Gale and Hattie Delph Bledsoe. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Zelma Muncy Bledsoe, by his daughter, Carlotta Bush, and by his brother, Kenneth G. Bledsoe.

Ewell was U.S. Navy Veteran. He was a very active community member who had previously served as the Mayor of Jonesville for 15 years.
