Ezra Hasque Neeley, age 91, of Stickleyville, VA, passed away peacefully at the Mountain Home V.A. Medical Center in Johnson City, TN. Born in Blackwater, VA on August 13, 1921, he was a son of the late Charlie Melvin and Virdie Mae (Lawson) Neeley.
