August 14, 1930 - November 21, 2024

Fredrick David Kiser, 94, passed away peacefully November 21, 2024 at Ridgecrest Nursing Home in Duffield, VA after a long illness. He was born August 14, 1930 to the late Fred and Bonnie Kiser in Phoenix, AZ.

He spent most of the early years of his life in the Los Angeles, CA area; graduating from the University of Southern California with honors. He was drafted into the US Army during the Korean War.

He spent his entire working career with Sears in Los Angeles, CA. After his retirement he returned to the roots of his family in Southwest, VA, where he spent the remainder of his life in the quiet rural Sugar Run community of West Jonesville, VA.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his sister Virginia Mooney (Crit) and a step son David Myers.

He is survived by his wife Peggy Fannon Kiser, two sons Jon and Ron Kiser, daughter Kathy Stark (Brian), five grandsons, one granddaughter, and a number of great grandchildren.

Fred's wishes were to be cremated with ashes placed in the McKinney-Carter Cemetery in Duffield, VA.
