



## Hugh Kyle Livesay Jr.

Hugh Kyle “Chewy” Livesay Jr., 57, of Kyles Ford, TN, passed away on Sunday, December 11, 2022 at his home.

He was born on May 19, 1965 to Glenda Faye Livesay and the late Hugh Kyle Livesay Sr. In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Fred and Ruby Livesay, and by his maternal grandparents, George Hobbs Jr. and Helen Hobbs.

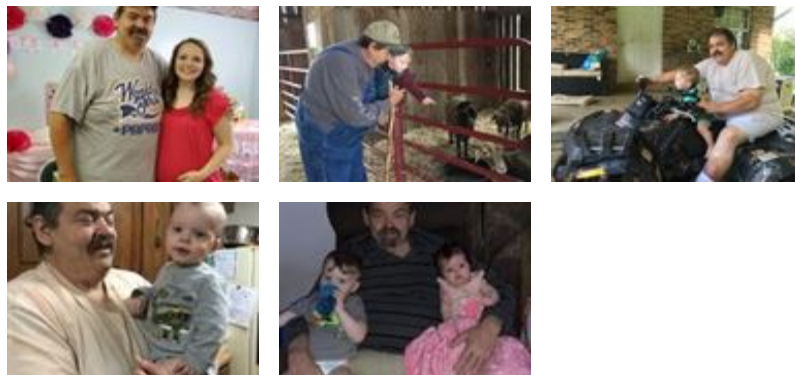
