Jack Bonham, 77, of Jonesville, VA ended his earthly journey on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 in Destin, Florida.

Jack was born on May 24, 1946 in Jonesville to the late Wiley and Mary Bonham. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his infant brother, John Wiley Bonham, Jr.

Jack was a U.S. Air Force Veteran who served in Vietnam. Following his service, he began working as a First Class Lineman with Dayton Power and Light in Ohio. He remained there until his retirement after 37 years of service. Jack was a lifetime member of the VFW and was a Freemason with the Preston Lodge #47 in Jonesville.

Jack enjoyed a lifelong love of playing music. He was a great guitarist and singer who had been a part of several bands throughout his life. He was a founding member of Town Branch Bluegrass who was always eager and willing to play at any time or place.
