Keith Marcum, affectionately known to everyone as "Mousey," left this world for his heavenly home on July 5, 2024. He passed away at home surrounded by his loving family.

Throughout his illness, Mousey experienced an outpouring of support from family, friends, neighbors, and the community. He was very grateful for all the love and support he received.

Mousey was born at home in Rose Hill, VA on July 4, 1956 and graduated from Thomas Walker High School in 1975. He spent 5 years as an EMT with the Lee County Ambulance Service before joining the Lee County Sheriff's Department in 1981, where he served as a deputy for the next 32 years. He retired as a sergeant in 2013.

One of Mousey's favorite things was having family all together for big holiday celebrations, complete with lots of food and laughter. He also enjoyed hunting and fishing with his buddies and spent many hours on the lake or in the woods. He liked to collect and trade, and it was very likely that, if there was an item you needed, he had it. On any given weekend, you could find him at the flea market (Mouse's House), surrounded by his many trading buddies. He loved being Papaw to his only grandchild, Sarah, aka "Papaw's Sugar Pumpkin."

Mousey was a wonderful person who spent a life well lived. He was loved by everyone who met him (even those he took to jail).

He is preceded in death by his parents Hubert and Annie Marcum; sisters Sherry Ann Marcum and Glenna Sue Marcum; grandson Andrew Scott Brooks; and brother-in-law John Huffman.

He is survived by his loving wife of 26 years, Geri Partin Marcum; son Randall Keith Marcum; daughters Chastity Brooks Lee (James) and Sarah "Bug" Brooks (Derek Huling); granddaughter Sarah "Papaw's Sugar Pumpkin" Bradley; sister Ruth Huffman (John); very special sister and brother-in-law, Cathy and Jay Partin; and a brother-in-law, Jimmy Parton. He is also survived by several cousins, nieces, and nephews. Additionally, Mousey is survived by his lifelong friend, Steve Jaynes and hunting/fishing buddy, Mike Yeary.
