Lydia Lavinia Elkins Hall, 72, of Jonesville, VA, passed away peacefully with her family by her side early Monday morning, September 2, 2013 at Wellmont Lee Regional Medical Center.

She was born in Lee County in the Wallen's Creek Community on August 13, 1941 to the late Hubert and Merle Elkins. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her ex-husband, Franklin R. Hall Sr., brother and sister-in-law, Patton and Ollie Elkins and two infant brothers.
