



Mildred Hurd McCoy

April 14, 1930 - March 14, 2025

Mildred Hurd McCoy, 94, of Blackwater, VA, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on March 14, 2025.

She was born in Scott County, VA on April 14, 1930, and moved to Hancock County, TN at the age of 6 months. She resided there until her marriage in 1953, attending schools in Hancock County and following her graduation, attended East Tennessee State University in Johnson City, TN. She also attended other colleges in Illinois including Quincy College and Spoon River College.

She married Charles McCoy Sr. on January 2, 1953, and to this union four children were born: Charles McCoy Jr, Teresa McCoy, Ramona McCoy and Tammie McCoy.

She was saved at Willis Chapel Church in February of 1942, where she joined and was baptized that same year. Upon moving to Meredosia, IL, she joined the Meredosia Baptist Church as an active member until 1987 when she moved to Blackwater, VA and joined Sarepta Baptist Church, where she remained a very active member, serving in any way she could until her death.

She was a devoted wife, mother, grand-mother, great-grandmother and teacher. She taught schools in Hancock and Hawkins County, TN from 1950

until 1954. She continued teaching in Morgan, Cass and Brown Counties in Illinois until 1972. She was also a registered EMT and Nurses Aid, working in Morgan and Brown Counties. She had also worked for Mountain Empire Older Citizens in Blackwater, VA and the surrounding areas until 1992. She was a member of the Eastern Star Chapter 443 of Sneedville, TN.

Mildred was preceded in death by her parents, Bessie Wright Hurd and Everette "Chief" Hurd; husband, Charles McCoy, Sr.; two daughters, Teresa McCoy and Ramona (Bedenbender) McCoy; son, Charles McCoy, Jr.; three sisters, Lucille Hurd Pepper, Evelyn Hurd Stoneham and Ruth Burton; three brothers, Elwood Hurd, Roy Hurd and Doyle "D.J." Hurd; two nieces, Dewell Hurd Herrill and Diane Pepper Wilson; two nephews, Gary and Brett Hurd; two brothers-in-law, Adrion Kinsler and Tom Burton; two sisters-in-law, Mozell Seal Hurd and Rosie Hurd; and a great-nephew, Christopher Hurd.
