



Ollie McHargue

February 5, 1918 - July 1, 2014

Ollie Montgomery McHargue, Age 96, passed quietly to her final resting place on July 1, 2014 at Lee Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Pennington Gap, Virginia.

She was preceded in death by her parents, E. L. (Lonnie) Montgomery and Bertie Shackelford Montgomery, her husband, Lester McHargue and all of her siblings; George Elmer Montgomery, Pauline Montgomery, Flossie Montgomery Rose, Alfred Eugene Montgomery.

Ollie was born in Rose Hill, Virginia and taught three (3) years in the public schools in Lee County at Brooks Hall south of Rose Hill on Martins Creek. When World War II began she went to Dayton, Ohio and worked for General Motors Delco division during the war. After the war ended her fiancé and she were married and they taught school in Kentucky and Ohio for years. She came back to Lee County in 1999 and resided in Jonesville until she fell and broke her hip and had to be cared for at Lee Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Mentally she was alert right until the end but physically she had declined since being unable to walk.

She is survived by her nephews, H. Ronnie Montgomery of Jonesville and George Elmer Montgomery of Rose Hill and her nieces Sandra Montgomery Parks of Rose Hill and Jean Isaacs of California and several great nephews

and nieces and several great- great nephews and nieces.
