



## Palmer Moore

December 28, 1930 - September 5, 2014

Palmer Moore, sometimes known as Poss, passed away at his home on Friday Evening, September 5th, 2014, at the age of 83. A lifelong resident of Lee County, Palmer was born on December 28th, 1930. He is preceded in death by his wife Rosalee Nelson Moore, his parents Lewis and Willie Mae Moore, brothers Grove and Billy Moore, sisters Golden Moore, Ocie Cope, Lois Moore, and Wanda Garrett, sister-in-law Ruby Moore, brothers-in-law Jack Nickodam, James Leonard, and William G.
