



Ray (Tobe) Depew

July 16, 1930 - March 25, 2025

Ray (Tobe) Depew, 94, of Massillon, Ohio, passed away on Monday, March 25, 2025, at Mercy Hospital, Canton, Ohio. Ray was born in Rose Hill, Virginia, on July 16, 1930, to the late Mack and Mary (Shell) Depew.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 69 years, Ruth (Bledsoe) Depew; four sisters, Lily Burgan, Eva Hall, Elizabeth Depew, and Wilma (Willie) Hair; three brothers, Edward, Homer, and Charles and grandson, Steven Depew. He is survived by five children: Gary Depew, of Canton, OH; Mary (John) Frank, of North Canton, OH; David (Lori) Depew, of North Canton, OH; Mark (Tara) Depew, of Massillon, OH; and Tim Depew, of Massillon, OH. Ray really enjoyed his work assignments with the military, and although he was employed by civilian employers such as the Louisville & Nashville Railroad (L&N) in the Jonesville, Virginia area and as a blacksmith with Cleveland Crane in Willoughby, Ohio, Ray really valued his vast military service in the U.S. Army.

1951-1953 - U.S. Army's 503rd Regimental Combat Team, 11th Airborne

Division, served in training missions in Alaska and participated in atomic testing in Nevada.

1954 – 1960 - Served with 179th AAA Gun Battalion as 1SG. with the Ohio Army National Guard in Willoughby, Ohio.

1960 – 1964 - 1st. Missile Battalion in Warrensville Heights, Ohio. Also Employed as a federal technician in support of the Nike Hercules Missile System. Where he much appreciated the camaraderie of all the Nike Site personnel reunions.

1964 – 1970 - Served as MSG position as Electronics Material Chief and Federal service for the Cincinnati/Dayton Nike Hercules Missile Battalion.

1970 – 1989 - N Troop 107th Air Cavalry Regiment, served as 1SG and worked as an aviation mechanic for Army Aviation Support Facility number 1 at the Akron Canton Airport. Served within Army Aviation for the 416th Engineer Group in Toledo, Ohio.

1989 Retired as Master Sergeant from 416th Engineer Group as a Helicopter Maintenance Supervisor, with 38 years as a federal technician.

Ray was a 60-year member of the American Legion.
