Robert Estes, age 83, of Jonesville, VA, peacefully passed away on December 29, 2025, at his home surrounded by the people and farm view he loved.

He was born on March 8, 1942, in Cawood, KY, a son of the late Luther and Nola Estes.

Throughout life, he was known for many things—kindness, generosity, and hard work among them. Sixty-five years ago, Robert bought a backhoe and created what would become Estes Bros Construction, which has made a lasting impact in his community and beyond. By employing hundreds throughout the years, finding ways to better community projects and roads, and always giving back to Lee County, his impact will be felt for years to come. Outside of work, he enjoyed traveling and had many adventures throughout the US, in South America and the Amazon, and could often be found exploring off-road in his Jeep. He was also known for raising bison for many years, as well as other exotic animals such as zebra, camels, and kangaroo. Robert treasured time spent with family and friends.

Robert is survived by his wife of 63 years, Julaine Estes, of Jonesville VA; his children: Sheri Jenkins and fiancé, Adam, of Kingsport TN, Greg Estes, of Jonesville, VA, and Kandi Loyer, of Jonesville, VA; his grandchildren, Austin

(wife, Tressa), Grayson (wife, Chelsie), Parker (husband, Aaron), Luke, and Grace; and great-grandchildren: Collins and Larson.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Luther Roy.

The family will receive friends from 5 until 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 1, 2026, at Friendship Baptist Church in Jonesville.
