Roberta Kay Daniels Mise, 88, passed away peacefully on June 11, 2025, at the home of her son, Stan Powers and his wife Mayla, in Jacksonville, Florida. Though she spent her final days in Florida, Roberta was a lifelong resident of Lee County, Virginia—a place she proudly called home.

Roberta dedicated twenty-four years of service as a cook for the Lee County Sheriff's Department, where she became a local legend for her homemade meals. Her biscuits and gravy were so beloved that folks often joked about getting arrested just for a chance to eat her cooking.

A devoted member of the Rose Hill Church of God for fifty-two years, Roberta faithfully served as the church clerk for thirty-eight of those years. She lived out her deep faith through her love for God, her family, and her community. Nothing brought her more joy than being surrounded by her children and grandchildren.

Later in life, Roberta became an enthusiastic football fan, passionately supporting her grandson Justin Gilliam throughout his high school and college football career. Saturdays in the fall were reserved for cheering on the University of Tennessee, often accompanied by her dog Knoxy, her grandson Shane, and her son Stan.

Roberta was preceded in death by her parents, Verda and Robert Daniels; her sisters, Lois Countiss, Shirley Hope, Johnnie Cannon, and Diane Daniels; her daughter, Tamara Powers Thompson; and her beloved grandson, Shane Dennis.

She leaves behind a legacy of love and cherished memories with her sister, Patsy Daniels Johnson and husband DJ; her daughters, Debra Powers Andreasen (and husband Jim Moore) and Ginger Powers Conkin (and husband Mark); her sons, James Powers (and wife Lisa), Stan Powers (and wife Mayla), and Steve Powers (and wife Leslie). Roberta was a proud grandmother to thirteen grandchildren and seventeen great-grandchildren.

She is also survived by her dear Aunt, Jannette Daniel, her treasured friend Judy Moore Blanton, and many beloved nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Roberta's warmth, humor, and faith touched every life she encountered. Her legacy will live on in the hearts of all who knew and loved her.
