



Sherman Lee Williams

January 1, 1934 - August 10, 2019

Sherman Lee Williams, age 85, affectionately known to his friends as “Sherm” and to his family as “Pap,” passed away on Saturday, August 10, 2019 at Holston Valley Medical Center in Kingsport, TN.

He was born in the Millers Chapel Community of Jonesville on January 1, 1934, as the 10th and youngest child, to the late Bill and Ollie Williams.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and proudly worked for 41 years in the maintenance department of the Lee County Public School System.
