Stephen Wayne "Moose" Marsee passed away Saturday, October 28, 2023 at his home in Jonesville. He was 66 years of age. He was born in Pennington Gap, VA on January 26, 1957. Following his birth, his family moved to Indianapolis, IN and later returned to Lee County in 1970.

He is survived by his daughter Amber Coomer, husband Brian, grandchildren, Brycen and Karsyn Coomer; sisters Sandy Martin and husband Cotton, Lisa Reisinger, Valerie Garrett, and one brother Brian Marsee, and several nieces and nephews.

He was known to many as an elite basketball player of the 1970s in Lee County. His career scoring record was 2,459 points and is currently 7th on the top scorers in the Virginia High School League. He was inducted in the Virginia High School League Hall of Fame in 2011 and was also inducted in the LMU hall of fame in 2014. He will always be known as a legend to many. He will always be known for his basketball skills on the court. He loved his daughter Amber more than anything in this world. He always called her his "favorite person." He also loved his grandchildren, Brycen and Karsyn. He encouraged them to be the best they could be.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Roy and Lorene Ely Marsee and one sister Robin Lester.

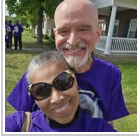
