Every time you got ready to leave he would say, "You can go home when you can't go nowhere else." He loved spending time with his family and loved ones when they came to visit him. He would always joke that all he needed was "a sack of hundred bills" if anyone asked if he needed anything. He was a big cut up and loved making everyone laugh.

Tyler was saved at an early age and he was a member of Davis Chapel. He

rededicated his life and was faithful to the end. He encouraged young and old alike through his testimony. He made sure his family knew as he battled his illness that he was going home either way. He either got out of the hospital and went to his worldly home or he went to his heavenly home. Tyler's faith held true and he found peace in the morning. He will truly be missed by his family who love him dearly and will cherish his memory forever.
