



## Veda Katherine Richmond

March 14, 1928 - January 14, 2025

Veda Katherine Richmond, 96, of Ewing, VA went to be with her Lord on Tuesday, January 14, 2025 at her home.

She was a lifelong resident of Ewing, VA and was born on March 14, 1928, to the late Oscar Herman Manning and Elizabeth Emeline (Sloan) Manning. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Tyler Nathaniel Richmond, and by her infant brother, James Wilkerson Manning.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Ewing for over 80 years where she had served as the Pianist, Sunday School Teacher and Clerk. She was a teacher in the Lee County School System for 42 years, first at Ewing for 2 years, and then 40 years at Thomas Walker High School.

She is survived by three daughters, Jane Richmond Musick, of Kingsport, TN, Judy Richmond, of Ewing, and Janet Nelson and husband, Hans, of Ewing; three grandchildren, Elizabeth Ann Musick, Katie Moore and husband, Brandon, and Tyler Nelson; great-grandchildren, Rayden Moore and one great-grandchild who will be arriving in July.

A graveside service will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, January 17, at Richmond Cemetery in Ewing with Mike Humfleet officiating. Everyone is asked to meet at the cemetery for services.
