Vester Yearly Dempsey, 95, of Ewing, VA and formerly of Lafayette, IN, was born on December 1, 1925 to the late Jacob and Minnie (Collins) Yearly, passed away on May 6, 2021 after a brief illness.

Vester left her home at an early age and went to Oak Ridge, TN where she was employed by the Army Services Forces Corps of Engineers Manhattan District Project. Her work was essential to the production of the Atomic Bomb which contributed to the conclusion of World War II. She received her appreciation on August 6, 1945.

She moved to Indiana and lived there 64 years until her retirement. She was a very adventurous person. She loved reading, quilting and working in her garden and yard. She was blessed with 95 wonderful years on this earth and enjoyed every day of it.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Dempsey; one brother, Chester Yearly; and three sisters, Pauline Caldwell, Shirley Wilson and Christine Delph.
