



## William "Mitchell" Snodgrass

October 6, 1959 - November 21, 2024

William "Mitchell" Snodgrass, 65, of Jonesville, VA, passed away on Thursday, November 21, 2021, at Johnson City Medical Center.

He was born on October 6, 1959, at Sugar Run, in Jonesville, VA, the fifth of six children born to the late Glenn and Trevia (Quinley) Snodgrass. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Darrell W. Snodgrass.

He worked in corrections for over 30 years. He was employed with the Virginia Department of Corrections, Lee County Sheriff's Office, and retired from the Southwest Virginia Regional Jail Authority in Duffield, VA in 2011. Mitchell spent most of his free time on the farm, from his early childhood until a short time before his death, working alongside his dad, brothers, and most recently his nephew, Austin.

He is survived by his brothers, Jim (Wanda) Snodgrass of Yale, Virginia, Ray (Vickie) Snodgrass, and Dan (Melissa) Snodgrass of Jonesville; his sister, Glenda Snodgrass Vance, of Kettering, Ohio; sister-in-law, Joyce Snodgrass, of Jonesville, VA; nephew, Austin (Callie, Reece, Dean and Gray) Snodgrass, of Pennington Gap, VA; nieces, Stephanie Wyatt, of Charles Town, WV, Ashely (Robert, Jaiden, Jerimiah, Raigen and Malikah) Vikara, Regina Moore, Kimberly Lee, and Sonya Welch, all of Jonesville, and Shannon Pillion of Gray, TN.

A graveside service will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 24, in Bethel Cemetery, located on Sugar Run Road in Jonesville, with Pastor Steve Neff officiating.
